- 2 - 4 weeks
- Specific time period will depend on resident and clinician availability
- Licensure is optional (Non-licensed residents may only observe)

- Salary support not included

#### Selection Process

- Osteo Science Foundation's Education Committee will evaluate all applicants
- Program Directors must approve observerships during application process prior to submission and review

- August 1 (for April 1 - June 1 applications)
- February 1 (for October 1 - December 1 applications)
